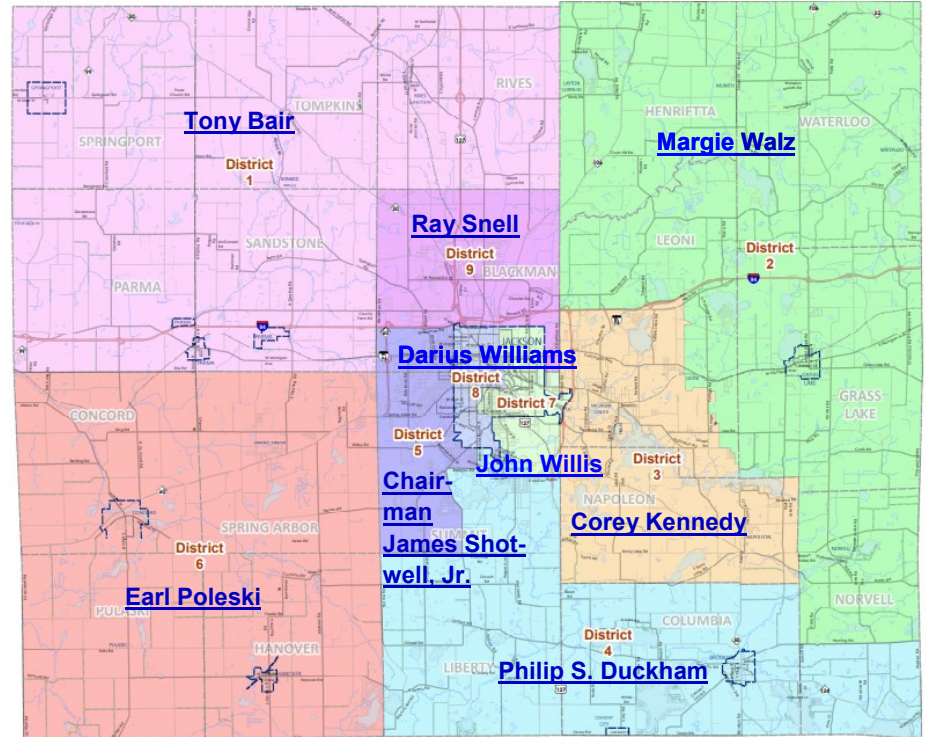

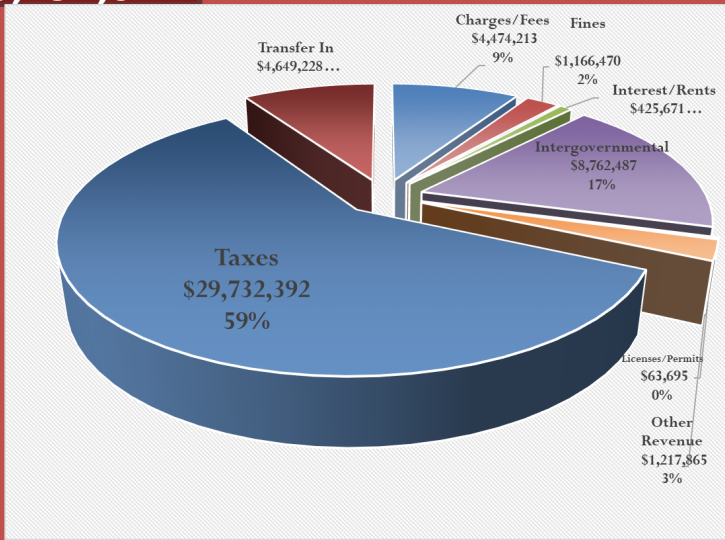

## GENERAL FUND REVENUES

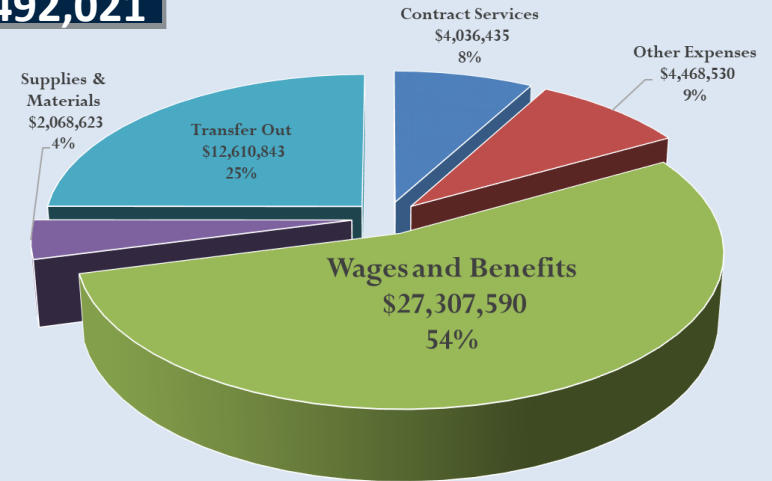

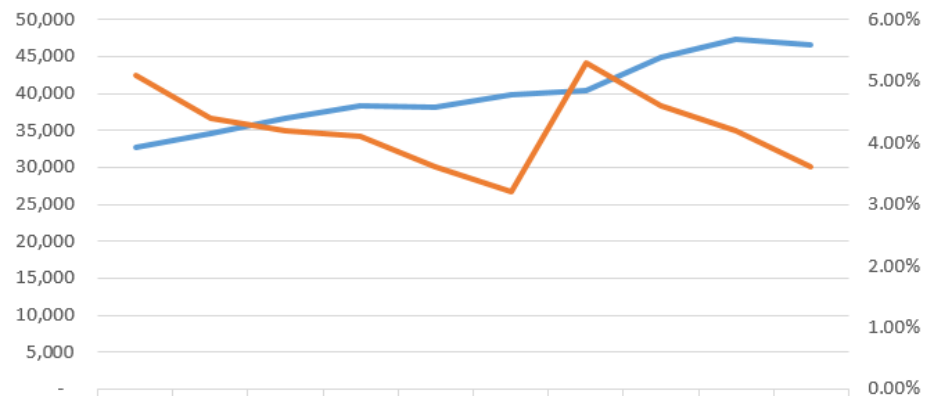

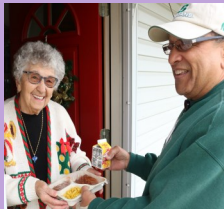
