Service: conducts re-examinations of drivers who have been referred because of health concerns. **\*\* Could not verify the following information.** Complete the “Request for Driver Evaluation” form #OC88 and mail or fax to the Driver Assessment Division listed on the form. Referral from doctor or multiple referrals help determine legitimate need for evaluation. Secretary of State notifies the driver to have their doctor certify they are able to take the exams required, and schedules an evaluation appointment. A vision test, written exam and road test may be given. Hours: Wed 9 AM-7PM, plus M, T, Th, Fr from 9-5 PM
