8. Has the adopting parent or any other adult in the home have any prior arrest or any Current contact with police agencies? (since the age of seventeen)

9. Has the adopting parent or any other adult in the home had any contact with protective services that resulted in a formal record of neglect, abuse, or domestic violence?

10. Has the adopting parent participated in any counseling/therapy related to:

Personal problems, marriage problems, grief counseling, stepfamily concerns, or any abuse as a child?

11. Has the adopting parent participated in any outpatient/inpatient therapy for alcohol Or drug use or abuse?
