BLACKMAN CHARTER TOWNSHIP
RESOLUTION TO ADOPT ROD MILLS PARK MILLAGE
BALLOT LANGUAGE

Shall the authorized charter millage for the Charter Township of Blackman, established for years 2017 through 2021 inclusive at .25 mills (\$0.25 Per \$1,000 of taxable value) and reduced to .2493 mills (\$0.2493 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be increased, back to the original millage of .25 mills (\$0.25 per \$1,000 taxable value) for Five (5) years, 2022 through 2026 inclusive, for the maintenance, improvements, enhancements, and additions to the Township park system, which .25-mills will raise an estimated \$139.495 in the first year the millage is levied.

PROPOSITION #1

MILLAGE RENEWAL FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES IN THE CITY OF JACKSON

Shall the Jackson Area Transportation Authority be authorized to levy for a period of five years (2023-2027 inclusive) for the purpose of providing public transportation services 1 mill on each dollar (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00) of taxable value as finally equalized.

The estimated revenue to be collected in the first year the millage is authorized and levied is \$550,000.

The proposed millage is a renewal of a previously authorized millage of one mill on August 2, 2016 and does not constitute new additional millage.

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF SANDSTONE

RENEWAL OF MILLAGE FOR

POLICE PROTECTION AND PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation, imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, in the Charter Township of Sandstone of 0.5 mill (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 0.4994 mills (\$0.4994 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, which is set to expire on December 31, 2022, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted 0.50 mill (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for five (5) years, 2023 through 2027 inclusive, to be used to provide police protection and public safety services for the residents of Sandstone Charter Township, whether by contracting for such services or establishing a police department. The remaining 3.8938 mills are only available to be levied to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the “Headlee” amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will only be levied to the extent necessary to restore that reduction.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Northwest Community Schools, Jackson and Ingham Counties, Michigan, be renewed by 21.8938 mills (\$21.8938 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2023 to 2032, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2023 is approximately \$4,300,000 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2022 tax levy)?

SINKING FUND MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the building and site sinking fund millage that expires with the 2022 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate of .7482 mill (\$0.7482 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) which may be assessed against all property in Litchfield Community Schools, Hillsdale, Jackson, Calhoun and Branch Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 4 years, 2023 to 2026, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2023 is approximately \$79,200 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2022 tax levy)?
