JAIL ADDITION AND SHERIFF'S OFFICE MILLAGE QUESTION

For the purpose of constructing, equipping, and financing an addition to the County Jail and a new Sheriff's Office to replace the existing building, and for their ongoing operating expenses, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Jackson, Michigan be increased by up to one (1) mill, \$1.00 per thousand dollars of state taxable valuation, for a period of twenty (20) years (2022-2041) inclusive?

If approved and levied in full, this Millage will raise an estimated \$5,275,280 in the first calendar year of the levy, based on state taxable valuation. If approved and levied, in accordance with State law a portion of the millage may be distributed to the Downtown Development Authorities of the City of Jackson, the Villages of Grass Lake and Springport, and the Townships of Blackman and Leoni; the Local Development Finance Authorities of the Village of Parma and the Township of Blackman; and the Brownfield Redevelopment Authority of the City of Jackson.

**JACKSON COUNTY CENTRAL DISPATCH
PROPOSITION FOR 9-1-1 SYSTEM FUNDING**

Shall the County of Jackson, Michigan, be authorized to assess a charge on all landline, wireless, and voice over internet protocol service users located in Jackson County of up to \$3.00 per month, to be used exclusively for the funding of 9-1-1 emergency telephone call answering and dispatch services within Jackson County, including facilities, equipment and maintenance, and operating costs?

**COLUMBIA SCHOOL DISTRICT
OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

This proposal will allow the school district to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Columbia School District, Jackson, Lenawee, Washtenaw and Hillsdale Counties, Michigan, be increased by .9921 mill (\$0.9921 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 2 years, 2023 and 2024, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2023 is approximately \$47,781 (this millage is to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will be levied only to the extent necessary to restore that reduction)?

ROAD MILLAGE RENEWAL**

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Concord Township, of one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) reduced to 0.9200 mills (\$0.92 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at 0.9200 mills (\$0.92 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for four (4) years, 2022 through 2025 inclusive, for the purpose of continuing to provide funds for the repair, improvement, and maintenance of roads within the Township, which will raise an estimated \$84,469.43 in 2022?

Leoni Township Road Improvement Bond Proposal

Extra Operating Renewal**

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Village of Cement City, of 4.9665 mills (\$4.9665 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 4.8771 mills (\$4.8771 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and increased up to the 4.9665 mills (\$4.9665 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 2 years, 2023 through 2024 inclusive, for general operating expenses for the Village of Cement City, raising an estimated thirty five thousand six hundred sixteen dollars (\$35,616.28) in the first year the millage is levied?

**SPRINGPORT PUBLIC SCHOOLS
OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance. The remaining 0.7725 mill is only available to be levied to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the “Headlee” amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will only be levied to the extent necessary to restore that reduction.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Springport Public Schools, Jackson, Calhoun, Eaton and Ingham Counties, Michigan, be renewed by 18.7725 mills (\$18.7725 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 8 years, 2023 to 2030, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2023 is approximately \$1,432,115 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2022 tax levy)?

**MARSHALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS
SINKING FUND MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Marshall Public Schools, Calhoun and Jackson Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 8 years, 2024 to 2031, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for, and the construction or repair of, school buildings, for school security improvements, for the acquisition or upgrading of technology, and for all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2024 is approximately \$875,000?

**NORTH ADAMS-JEROME PUBLIC SCHOOLS
SINKING FUND MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the building and site sinking fund millage that expires with the 2022 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate of .6795 mill (\$0.6795 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) which may be assessed against all property in North Adams-Jerome Public Schools, Hillsdale and Jackson Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 10 years, 2023 to 2032, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2023 is approximately \$102,232 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2022 tax levy)?
