JAIL OPERATIONS MILLAGE QUESTION

For the purpose of funding ongoing operating expenses of the Jackson County Jail, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Jackson, Michigan be increased by up to 0.25 mills (\$0.25 per thousand dollars of state taxable valuation), for a period of ten (10) years (2024-2033) inclusive? Library Millage Renewal Proposal

This proposal will allow the college to restore its originally authorized charter millage rate of 1.33 mills on all property, with the revenue of this proposal to be used for enhancing job training, job placement and professional trades education programs.

erecting, furnishing, and equipping a new elementary school building within the territory of the former Albion Public Schools school district; erecting, furnishing, and equipping additions to school buildings, including a secure vestibule addition at Hughes Elementary School; remodeling, furnishing and refurnishing, and equipping and re-equipping school buildings, including adding air conditioning to Gordon Elementary School and Marshall Middle School; acquiring and installing instructional technology and instructional technology equipment for school buildings; and preparing, developing, improving, and equipping playgrounds and sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2025, under current law, is 2.30 mills (\$2.30 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is thirty (30) years.
