

ROUND DANCE - Social Ballroom



BEGINNING ROUND DANCE

- A choreographed ballroom dance where couples follow a “cuer” through pre-set figures to music.
- Couples dance in a circle, progressing around the dance floor in a counter-clockwise direction.
- A leader, or “cuer”, calls out the dance steps just ahead of the music, allowing all dancers to perform the same figures in unison.
