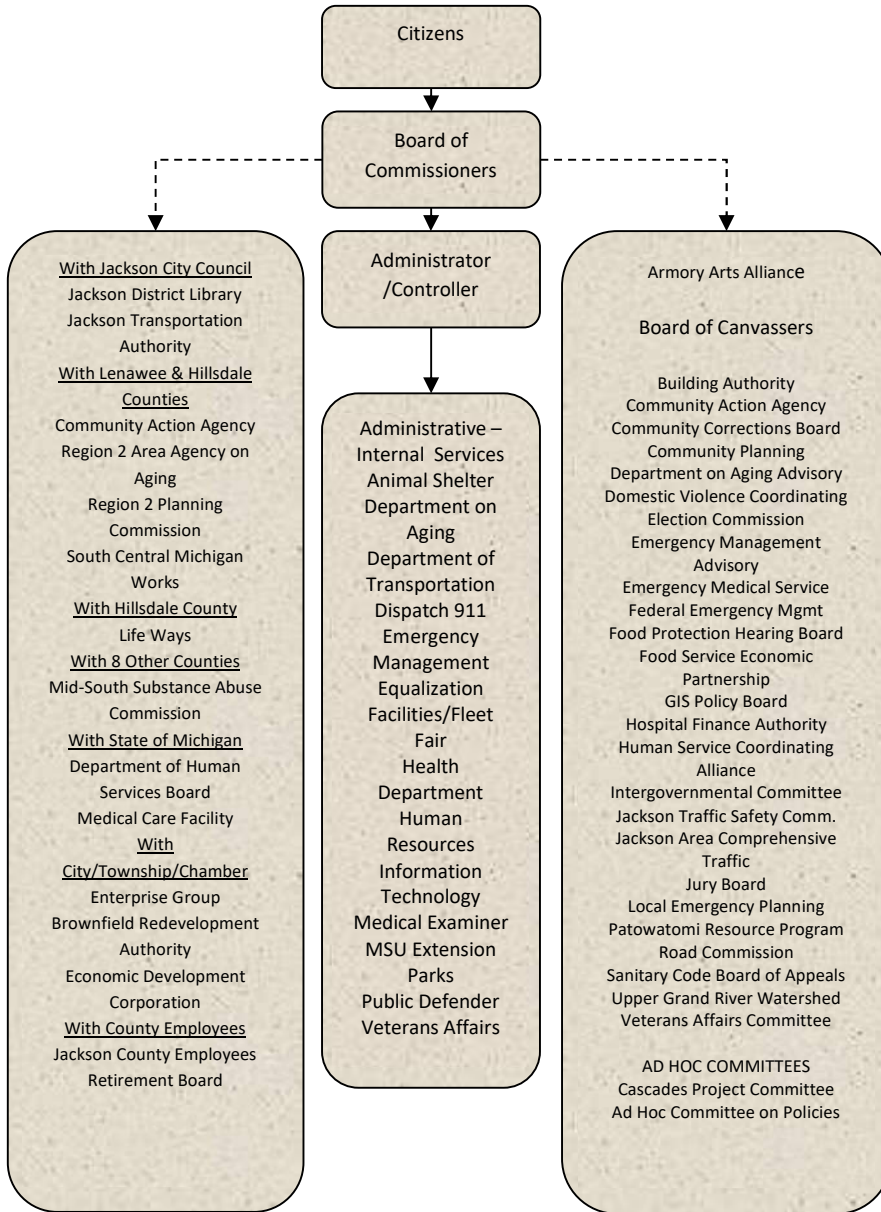

Accomplishments

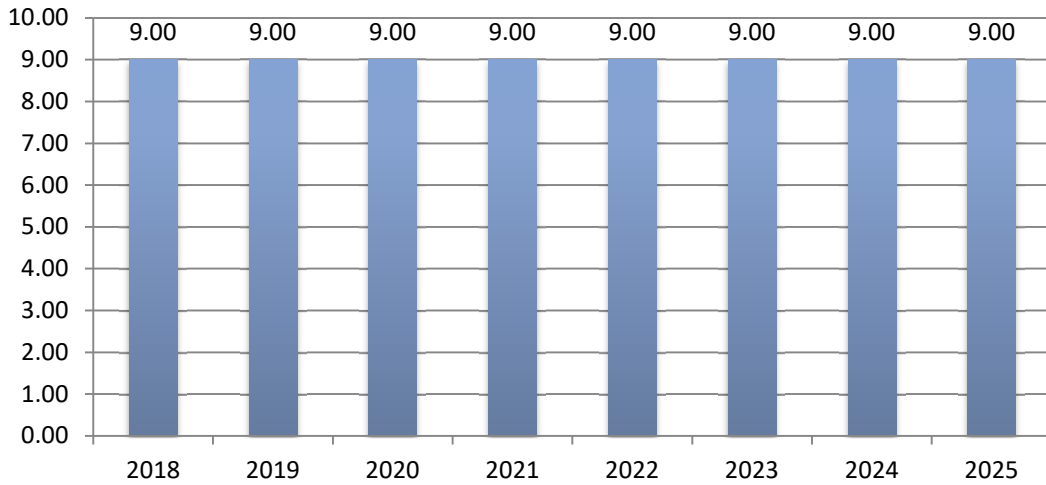
- Continued support of county wide broadband efforts through creation of Broadband committee.
- Host successful and safe Jackson County Fair.
- In partnership with local agencies, continued utilization of opioid settlement funds within the health department, to provide prevention, education and distribution of naran in our community, including partnership with Home of New Vision's Engagement Center project.
- Continue governmental transparency through FOIA requests and Boarddocs on line electronic agenda.
- Continue successful updates to county parks with millage funding, including updates to picnic shelters at Grass Lake County Park, Gillette's Lake County Park and Little Wolf Lake County Park, as well as erosion control and improved lake access at Falling Waters Trail & Lime Lake.
- Completion of utilization federal ARPA funds in a responsible manner, including for utility (watermain and stormwater) improvements at the Jackson County airport, masonry repairs, tuck pointing and repaving of the parking lot at the Courthouse building, and tuck pointing and masonry repairs that the Northlawn Building.
- Continued focus on environmental concerns, including remediation of the Michner Plating site in partnership with the EPA and EGLE.
- Continued utilization of Local Bridge program grant funds, through MDOT, to repair and/or replace, and improve Jackson County bridges, consistent with the values in the 2025 Strategic Plan.
- Successful start to energy Veregy project, projected to save millions of dollars in tax payer dollars.
- Utilization of mostly federal funds to improve Jackson County Airport, including the air traffic control tower, the water main and storm water improvement.

No significant budget adjustments have been recommended in the 2026 budget.
