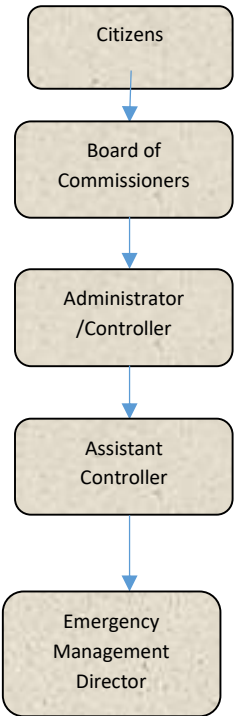


Emergency Management



Activities

Emergency management is concerned with protecting the people and properties of Jackson County.

The division continues to work with the public safety community and public health community, along with local critical infrastructure and key resources to mitigate, prepare, respond and recover from potential disasters.



Strategic Plan Impact

✓ **Safe Community**

Working with the Department of Homeland Security and the Michigan State Police Emergency Management Division, it is the goal of Emergency Management to make Jackson a safer community utilizing an all-hazards approach in dealing with potential disasters.

Accomplishments

- Jackson County OEM assisted Jackson Community Foundation in establishing the Jackson Strong Fund for disaster relief.
- Jackson County OEM assisted the United Way of South Central Michigan with initial developments of the Community Resiliency Program.
- Jackson County OEM implemented Genasys ALERT and EVAC mass notification solutions.
- Jackson County OEM completed Safety & Security Threat Assessment at DaVinci Primary School.
- Jackson County received , \$30,210.14 (FY2022), \$46,428.77 (FY2023) and \$31,903.21(FY2024) from the Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP).
- Jackson County received \$ \$12,428.00 from the 2024 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) and
- Jackson County received \$ \$1,560from the 2024 Hazardous Materials Emergency Planning Grant (HMEP)
- Private sector business emergency and safety plans were reviewed and assessed by Jackson County OEM
- Off-site response plans and Tier II reports were updated for all Hazardous Materials sites within Jackson County.
- Jackson County OEM met with local school districts to review and update their Emergency Response Plans

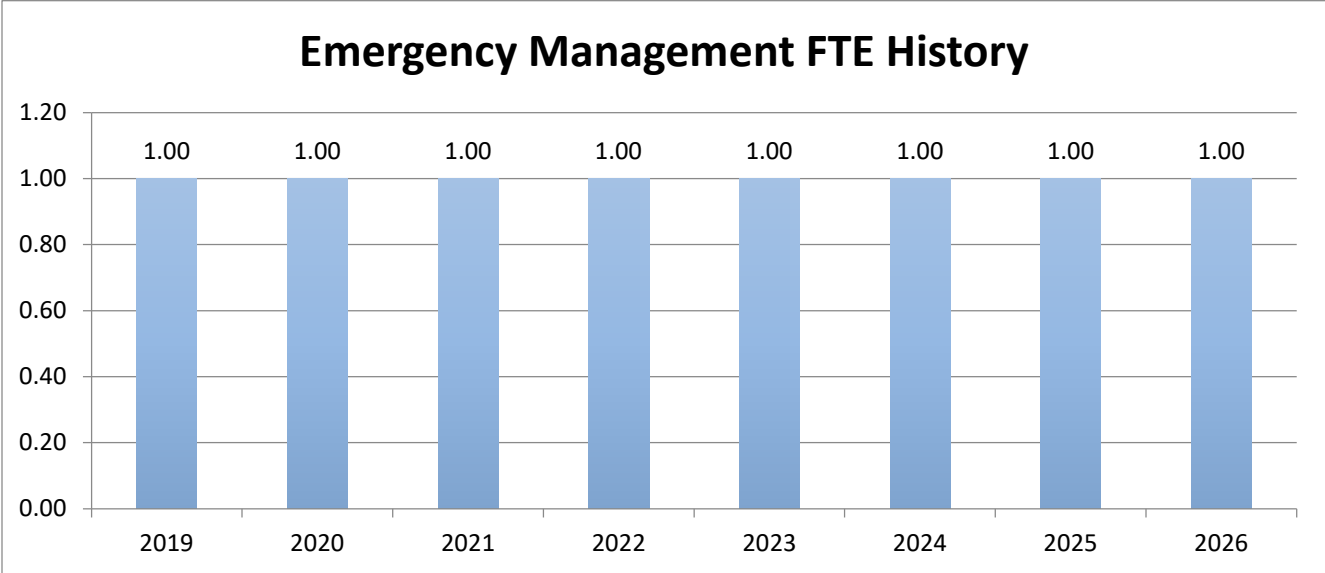
- Jackson County OEM updated local support plans for communities with a population of 10,000 or more as required by Mi.PA.390.
- Emergency Mass notifications were sent out 31 times during 2024-2025 for missing children, endangered missing adults, lockdown events, traffic crash roadway closures, situational awareness and life safety events. 24 notifications were sent for weather warnings.
- **Local projects completed with HSGP funds:**
- Jackson County Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) Team Technical Rescue Confined Space Training. Jackson County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Staff Laptops and equipment
- Jackson Community Ambulance HazMat Equipment
- Jackson County Law Enforcement Individual First Aid Kits (IFAK)
- Jackson County Hazmat Boom
- Jackson County Hazmat Chlorine Kit

Jackson County OEM participated in several Regional and Local exercises and Trainings in -2024-2025.

- Jackson County OEM participated in several local, regional and state exercises.
- Jackson County participated in the Statewide Tornado Drill and Severe Weather Preparedness week in March.
- Jackson County OEM and Jackson Fire Department hosted a three day multi-agency active shooter full scale exercise.
- Jackson County OEM hosted a train derailment hazardous materials tabletop exercise.
- Jackson County OEM hosted a multi-scenario tabletop exercise for Jackson County Fair and Keeley Park staff.
- Jackson County OEM hosted SKYWARN Weather Spotter Training.
- Jackson County OEM hosted ICS 300- Intermediate Incident Command System for Expanding Incidents.

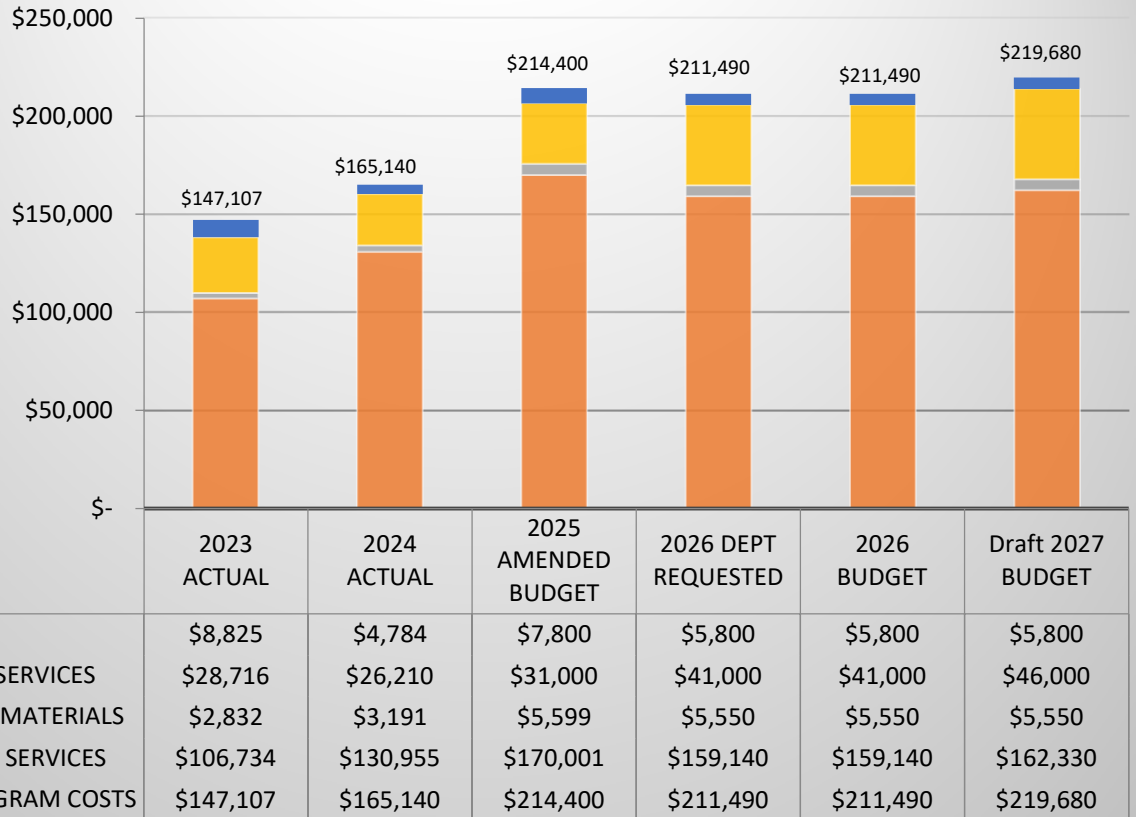
Budget Adjustments
