

Home Health Care Hospices

Hospices provide home care for terminally ill clients, emphasizing pain relief and symptom management. Services include a visiting nurse, social worker, home health aid for bathing help, spiritual support, medical equipment, prescription drugs needed for comfort, and volunteer services. Eligibility: The patient needs a doctor's diagnosis of a terminal illness with a six month or less anticipated life expectancy and chooses to no longer seek aggressive treatment for a cure of their disease.
