

JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

RESOLUTION 06-17.12 TO APPROVE THE
JACKSON COUNTY IMMUNIZATION REGULATION

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Health Department works with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) to uphold the mandates of the Required Childhood Immunizations for Michigan School Settings, as required by the Michigan Public Health Code; and

WHEREAS, the Health Department is responsible for enforcing the immunization requirements and to provide non-medical immunization waivers; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its statutory obligations, the Health Department has produced a School Immunizations Procedures Manual for use by schools, parents, students, and health care professionals; and

WHEREAS, the Health Department has presented a proposed Jackson County Immunization Regulation (copy attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by reference) to assist in its enforcement of State and local immunization and communicable disease laws; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan Public Health Code (MCL 333.2441) authorizes the local governing entity of a local health department (Jackson County Board of Commissioners for the Jackson County Health Department) to approve regulations adopted by the health department that are necessary or appropriate to implement or carry out the duties or functions vested by law in the local health department; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing was given in accordance with Section 2442 of the Public Health Code (MCL 333.2442) not less than 10 days before the public hearing, and not less than 20 days before adoption of the regulation; and

WHEREAS, the Health Officer has notified the Board of Commissioners on May 31, 2017 that notice of the scheduled 2017 public hearing was published in the Jackson Citizen Patriot on May 25, 2017, and has recommended that the Board of Commissioners approve the Jackson County Immunization Regulation to establish regulations governing immunizations, immunization records, exemptions, exclusions from school for non-immunized students, administrative guidelines, and sanctions.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Jackson, Michigan, having reviewed the Immunization Regulation developed by the Health Department, and having considered the comments made at the public hearing on June 6, 2017, hereby approves the Jackson County Immunization Regulation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Jackson County Immunization Regulation shall take effect and be implemented by the Health Officer 45 days after the date of this Resolution.
