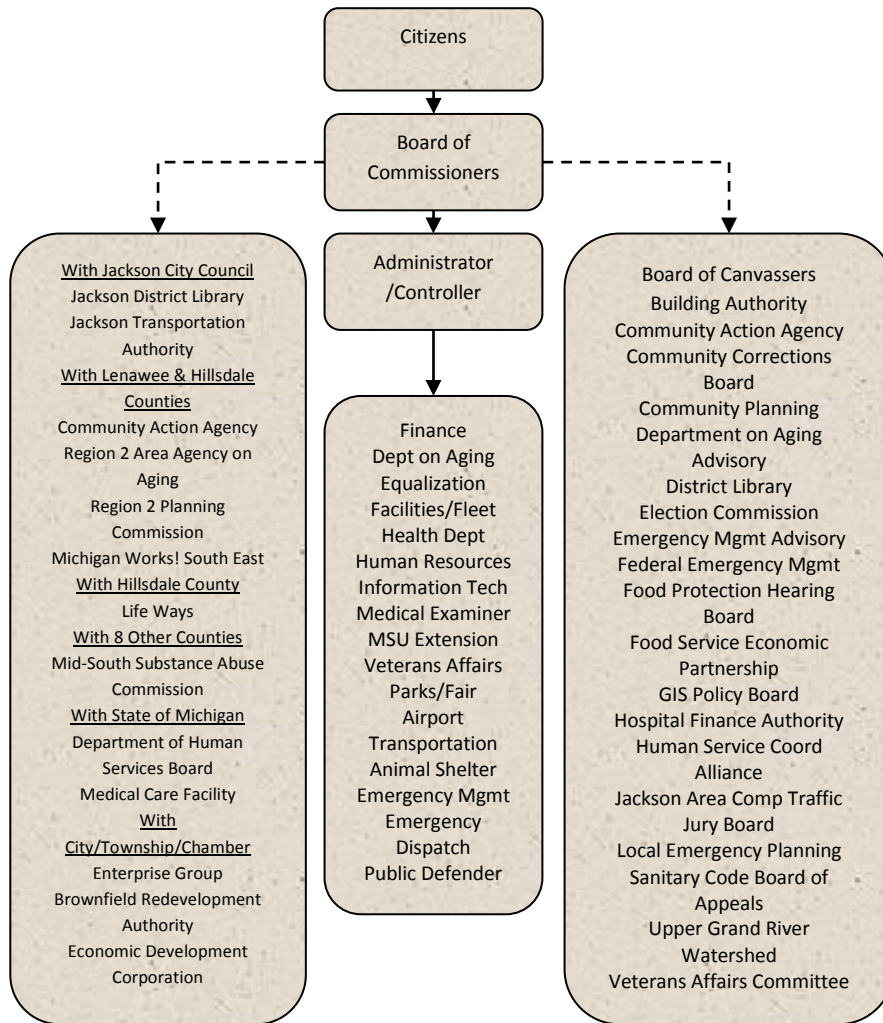




Board of Commissioners

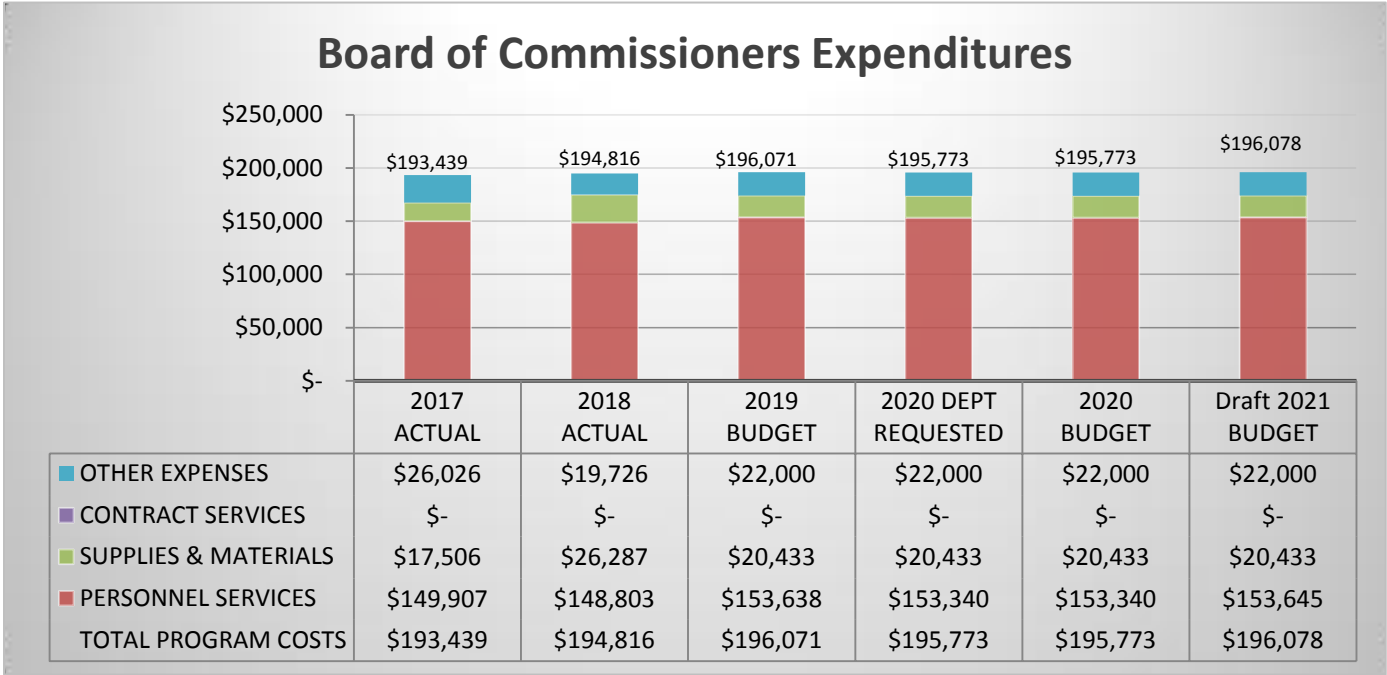
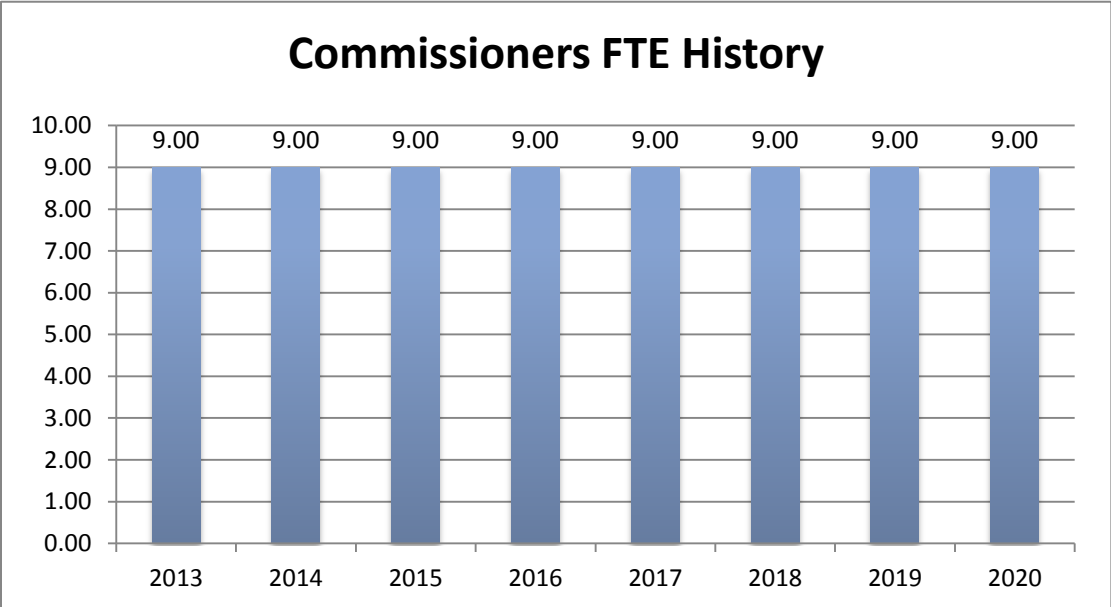
